### RAMBLIN RUM PARK, DUNLOP PARK, SEEYLE BROOK TRAIL, RIVER MEADOWS PARK

#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Regular meeting May 17, 2023  
**Commissioner Oman moved, second by Commissioner West to approve the May 17, 2023 meeting minutes. Motion carried 5-0.**

#### NEW BUSINESS

2. Ramlin Rum Park  
Commissioners inspected the new decks on the playground. They also noted the swings have been fixed and a new park sign installed and are happy with the improvements.
3. Dunlop Park  
Commissioners viewed the new benches that were donated by the Oak Grove Lions. They also noted some of the trees in front of the parking lot were removed for a better view of the sledding hill from vehicles. Chair Tri stated he is getting a quote for floating dock sections across the wetland on the south side of the property. He estimates \$30,000 installed.
4. Seeyle Brook Trail  
Commissioners walked the trail and looked at possibility of clearing more of trail/park area to better connect to River Meadows Park. They also noted the sign at the trail entrance has faded and needs to be replaced.
5. River Meadows Park  
Commissioners asked if Public Works could clean up sand on boat launch. They also asked about mowing the tree line in the parking lot to create a path along the wild flowers.

#### Commissioner Discussion Items

- Comm West brought up removing the remaining lights on the trees at City Hall. Administrator Wickham stated he is working with Public Works but we need to come up with a long-term solution.
- Commissioners discussed touring parks again in August
- Next meeting is July 19<sup>th</sup> at City Hall at 6:30 p.m.
