OAK GROVE PARKS COMMISSION
APRIL 20, 2022
DUNLOP PARK

Chair Tri called the regular meeting of the Oak Grove Parks Commission to order at 6:00 pm at Dunlop Park

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. Regular meeting March 16, 2022
Commissioner West moved, second by Commissioner Hodel to approve the March 16, 2022 meeting minutes. Motion carried 5-0.

NEW BUSINESS

2. 4H Pollinator Garden
4H member Gianna Brostrom presented the concept of a pollinator garden in a city park to the commission on February 16th. The Commissioners reviewed potential site for the 5' x 10' pollinator garden at Dunlop Park and decided near the intersection of the short loop and the long trail route was the best area. The area was flagged so 4H could start on the pollinator garden install soon.
3. Oak Grove Preserve Park – Pickleball Court
Commissioners reviewed quotes from CSR, Surface Pro and Minnesota/Wisconsin Playground for the project. Commissioners recommended Surface Pro for the court construction since they were lower and Minnesota Wisconsin Playground for the posts and net. Chair Tri also got a quote for fencing (190' of black chain link fence with a top and bottom rail) for \$8,100. Staff will get another quote for fencing.
Court Install \$7,200, nets \$1,593 and fencing \$8,100 for an approximate total of \$16,893.
Motion by Commissioner West, second by Commissioner Hodel to recommend approval to construct a pickleball court using park dedication funds at Oak Grove Preserve Park to the City Council. Motion carried 5-0.

Commissioners reviewed the trail system at Dunlop Park including the new segment on the south side of the property. They agreed to connect to the neighborhood across Nightingale St. NW and to look at option for crossing the wetland with a floating dock or something similar. Staff will research options and bring back quotes for review at an upcoming meeting.

ADJOURMENT

Motion by Commissioner Pederson, second by Commissioner Oman to adjourn the meeting at 7:05 PM. Motion carried 5-0.
